Welcome to the 2024 edition of the KUMU Percussion Ensemble! This document contains important information regarding this year's marching percussion clinics, audition, and summer training camps.

Auditioning with an unfamiliar ensemble might feel overwhelming for new members but don't fret! We're just getting a feel for where everyone is at in their musical journey. Relax and have fun playing drums!

Step One - Sign up. No really, this is important!

First and foremost, be sure to sign-up for Kutztown University Marching Unit by filling out the online membership form located below. This allows us to plan to ensure you have the best experience while you're here!

Step Two - Attend in-person percussion clinics and get ahead!

As we tell our members, there are many ways to approach percussion. The "KUMU way" is one of those ways that may or may not be what you already know. To help get potential new members on the same page, we host two free marching percussion clinics to review terminology, basic technique, and approach to each instrument. We also comb through all audition material and requirements, providing lots of helpful tips and hints along the way. This will benefit everyone, especially new members!

All members are required to attend our in-person percussion basic training clinics listed below. We will meet at Schaeffer Auditorium. More info will be sent out via e-mail.

Saturday, May 4, 2024 from 10am-5pm Sunday, June 9, 2024 from 10am-5pm

Things you need to bring to all percussion events:

- ▲ 2024 Technique and Warm-up Packet
 - Available for download at www.kumubears.com/drumline
- marching snare/tenor sticks (Front Ensemble/Bass drummers We will provide mallets for the audition and season. Cymbals you may bring gloves if you wish, but we will supply all other gear.)
- △ drum pad(s) and tall snare stands bring more if you have extras!
- ▲ pencil/highlighters
- ▲ open mind and a positive attitude!

Step Three - Prepare your audition to be great!

Individual auditions and placements will be held on:

Saturday, July 20, 2024 from 10am-5pm

<u>Please arrive early</u> to fill out all necessary paperwork before you enter the audition room. The audition will be conducted in two parts:

1. Individual Audition

You will perform the required pieces specified below. Memorization is not required but is <u>highly recommended</u>. Please be prepared to play these exercises around the tempi listed.

Battery

All battery members will mark time for all pieces.

Snare Drum

- Some Accents & More Taps, 110-120 bpm
- Triplet Roll Sequence, Letter A-E (One time though not including "Stretchums"), 130-140 bpm

Bass Drum

- Some Accents & More Taps (Snare part), 110-120 bpm
- Check Patterns, 90-100 bpm
- Goldie's Revenge V (Letter C to D), 116 bpm

Quads (with split parts)

- Golden Quad Sweeps, 110-120bpm
- Some Accents & More Taps, 110-120 bpm
- Triplet Roll Sequence, Letter A-E (One time though not including "Stretchums"), 130-140 bpm

Cymbals

- Cinco Gato Legatos, 130 bpm
- Some Accents & More Taps, 110-120 bpm

Front Ensemble

Mallet players may choose to audition on 2 or 4 mallet instruments. A 4-mallet audition is recommended for those with previous 4-mallet experience.

Keyboard - 2 Mallets

- Peg (Measures 13 22) in C Major, 108 bpm
- Calypso Remix (Version 1), 120 bpm
- Relax V (Xylo Part) letter G to the end, 112 bpm
- Timing, 100 bpm

Keyboard - 4 Mallets

- Peg (Measures 13 22) in C Major, 108 bpm
- Broccoli (First 6 Measures). 90 bpm
- Calypso Remix (Version 2), measures 18-34 (at your own comfortable tempo)
- Pizza Beginning to the down beat of the 2/4 bar. 90-100 bpm
- Timing, 100 bpm

Auxiliary Rack

To be played on a drum.

- The Check Pattern, 110 bpm and 160 bpm
- The Check Pattern (Variations 1-4), 120 bpm (continuous)
- The Check Pattern (Variations 5-8), 120 bpm (continuous)
- Timing, 100 bpm

Synthesizer

- Peg (Measures 13 22) in C Major, 108 bpm
- Calypso Remix (Version 1), 120 bpm
- Relax V, 120 bpm
- Timing, 100 bpm

2. Group Placement Audition

Drumming is more fun with everyone! The second part will consist of us observing you in your assigned instrument group in an ensemble setting. The battery will play through Cinco Gato Legatos, Some Accents & More Taps, Triplet Roll Sequence, and 7/8 Bear-A-Diddles as an ensemble. For bass drummers, this time will be used to place you on different drums to find the best fit for you in the section. The front ensemble will play various scales, Peg, Calypso Remix, and Relax V. Expect to be moved around to other instruments - please be patient during this process.

"Help! I won't be able to attend the audition day!"

We highly recommend all students audition in-person but in the unfortunate event you're unable to attend the live audition, we may be able to setup an alternative audition option for you. Battery auditionees should contact Matt Urquhart (maturquhar@kutztown.edu) and Front Ensemble auditionees should contact Danny Mark (danmark@kutztown.edu) as soon as possible.

Step Four - Prepare for summer training camp

After you accept your position in the ensemble, you must have ALL exercises in the packet learned and prepared prior to arriving at summer training camp. We will need to maximize rehearsal time by practicing certain techniques and skills, not learning notes to exercises. Members will be required to move into their dorms before camp (TBD) so it is important to pack everything you need for summer training camp and your fall school semester.

- Percussion summer move-in to campus: Tuesday, August 13, 2024 from 5pm-6pm (More info to follow)
- Summer percussion training camp: Wednesday, August 14 Saturday, August 25, 2024 (all day, schedule TBD)

Many of our returning members will agree that our summer percussion training camp at KU is a highly anticipated part of the fall semester.
